Reflective Portfolio

Your Writing Task

This assignment has three components:

1. Original and revised copy of one of your first three major essays this semester (Memoir, Comparison of Douglass and Corcoran, or Critique of Oppenheim's article on television violence).
2. Memo discussing your revisions and the philosophy or strategy you used in making the revisions.
3. Reflective letter discussing the two or three most important things you learned this semester in English 102.

Mechanical Details

- For item #1, submit your original copy AND the instructor's grade sheet, along with a revised copy.
- The revision memo (item #2 above) should be one or two pages.
- The reflective letter (item #3) will be two or three pages.
- The revision memo (#2) and the reflective letter (#3) will be typed, not handwritten.

Submitting the paper:

- This assignment does not have a Blackboard drop box. You will submit paper copies in class.
- To keep everything together, please submit all of your material in a pocket folder or a large envelope.
 - If you cannot afford a folder or envelope, the instructor will have a few spares in class.
 - Do not get too fancy about this. Do not buy plastic page protectors or an expensive notebook. A simple pocket folder is sufficient.
